1. Discussion occurred regarding possible replacement of hand lights on ETA-625. Commissioner Schanz to investigate pricing for replacement handlights and chargers, if needed..

Bills

Bids for Boat Launch

One bid was received for construction of the boat launch:

Crescent Woods Subdivision

There was discussion on the proposed subdivision on Crescent Rd. The plots shown on the map to be in our district will stay in our district.

Station #3 Remodel

There was a discussion with Steve Rowland about the needs for a remodeled Station #3. He will begin with the Town codes to see what can be done.

SCBA Upgrades

New mounting brackets are needed to install the new SCBAs on R-631, ETA-622 and ETA-626. Commissioner Pettis made a motion to hire MES to replace approximately nineteen brackets on R-631, ETA-622 and ETA-626 for a cost not to exceed \$2,000. Commissioner Lindsey seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Water Pressure at Station #1

There is low water pressure at Station #1. We believe there is a 1" line coming into the station. We have talked with Aqua Science and received two options:

- 1. a bladder tank before the water softener
- 2. a larger (2" or larger) water line

We will speak with the Water Authority first to determine what size line is coming into the building.
